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Personality Questionnaires

There is a range of personality questionnaires that you may be asked to sit, for selection and/or development purposes.

All of the exercises will ask you questions concerning your interests, preferences and feelings about a range of things.

You will be presented with a series of statements and asked to rate yourself on a scale, according to how much you agree or disagree with each statement.

The number of response choices on the scale differs between some of the exercises. You will either be given a five-point or a three-point scale.

Proceed to the next page to answer some personality questionnaire sample questions.

1. Example format for a five-point scale questionnaire (Jung Type Indicator, Occupational Personality Profile, Occupational Interest Profile)

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2. Example format for a three-point scale questionnaire (15FQ/15FQ+)
